

## **COVID-19: Sample classification of cases based on acuity**

Acuity	Definition	Examples
Elective	Can be postponed beyond 30 days	<ul> <li>IVC filter retrieval</li> <li>Uncomplicated implant removal (e.g., port catheter)</li> <li>Prostate artery embolization</li> <li>Thyroid FNA</li> <li>Liver biopsy for cirrhosis</li> <li>Routine tube exchanges</li> </ul>
Time sensitive	Must be performed within 30 days	<ul> <li>TACE/TARE/ablation</li> <li>Long-term central venous catheter placement</li> <li>Biopsy for cancer diagnosis</li> <li>Gastrostomy tube placement</li> <li>Pain interventions</li> </ul>
Urgent	Must be performed within 72 hours	<ul> <li>Dialysis graft declot</li> <li>Tunneled dialysis catheter placement</li> <li>Catheter-based drainage of infected collection</li> </ul>
Emergent	Must be performed immediately	<ul> <li>Embolization for bleed</li> <li>Pulmonary embolism lysis</li> <li>TIPS for bleeding varices</li> <li>Arterial interventions for limb or bowel ischemia</li> </ul>
